### **AIRCRAFT MANUFACTURER MOVING TO CALGARY**

*Epic AIR elects Calgary for aircraft certification*

Calgary, Alberta, January 30, 2006 – Bend, Oregon-based Epic AIR, creator of the revolutionary Epic LT announced today that they will break-ground next month to build facilities dedicated to aircraft certification.

Epic AIR's investment will create between 400-600 jobs with an infusion of over \$100M in the local economy over the next three years. Plans to build a 100,000 sq. ft. certification factory are underway with growth mapped to over of 400,000 sq ft. of factory facility. Epic AIR's CEO Rick Schrameck stated, "the unexpected support we received from Merlin Preuss and his staff at Transport Canada established that Canada is the right choice for Epic."

Springbank Airport will be the new headquarters for the aircraft manufacturer beginning with an experimental customer build center scheduled to be online in less than six weeks. The preliminary 21,000 sq ft facility will operate as a completion center for the company's experimental kits.

The Springbank Airport was selected from numerous contenders who have been making presentations to Epic over the last six months. "Calgary's Springbank airport was awarded our investment as a result of the terrific assistance from the folks at the Calgary Airport Authority," stated Schrameck.
